1. Data Review (data coaches)
  - a. High school practice ACT: Awaiting final results. A team will analyze results and offer remediation based on strands of data.
  - b. Grades 3-8 Reading OLPA: Results were similar to last year.
2. Strategic plan check-in (guest presentation)
  - a. Initiative: "Develop a review process to monitor and enhance Talented and Gifted Programs" (Rosario Mollo, TAG teacher)
    - i. Numbers are increasing in TAG activities (approximately 150 participants across all the activities)
    - ii. Young students ask when they can begin certain activities (i.e., Robotics)
  - b. Initiative: "Assess inclusion of STEM courses and programs in district curriculum" (Megan Schimek, PLTW teacher)
    - i. Biomedical science. Last year, 27/29 students passed the course and got college-level credit, and 13 of those students got the highest possible score. 23 students this year.
    - ii. Human body systems. 6 students this year.
    - iii. Student feedback has been positive.
    - iv. Recommendation: Continue to offer it as an elective.
